**EXCESSIVE SWELLING
AROUND BITE SITE**

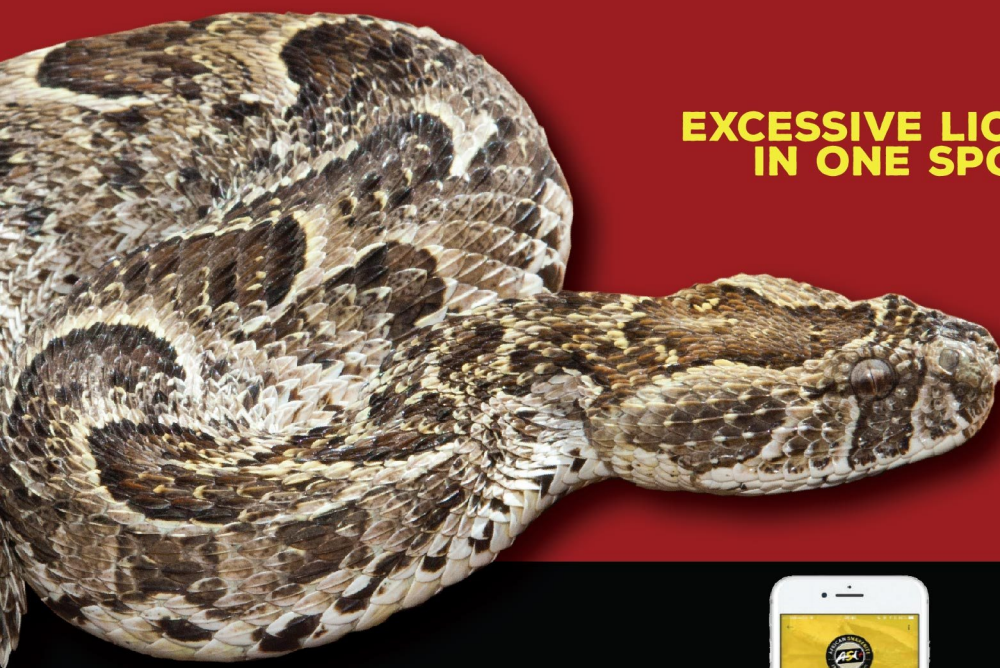
**BLEEDING & BLISTERING
AROUND BITE SITE**

DO NOT

- ... apply a tourniquet.
- ... cut and suck the wound.
- ... force charcoal down the throat.
- ... force milk down the throat.
- ... give animal Allergex tablets.
- ... give animal cortisone, painkillers or antihistamine.
- ... cut the tip of the ear to "bleed out" the venom.
- ... attempt to catch or kill the snake.
- ... inject antivenom randomly.
- Antivenom (if required) must be administered by a vet.

**IF POSSIBLE AND SAFE
TO DO SO, GET A
PHOTO OF THE SNAKE.**

**IN THE EVENT OF A SNAKE
BITE, TRANSPORT THE DOG
TO NEAREST VET CLINIC
WITHOUT DELAY.**
