COMMON SNAKES OF PRETORIA EAST



Pretoria East has around 35 species of snakes. Five species are considered highly venomous. Three species are venomous and two others can deliver a painful bite that may require stitches. Nine species are mildly venomous and the rest are harmless to humans.

HIGHLY VENOMOUS

Has caused human fatalities

VENOMOUS

Painful bite, but does not require antivenom

MILDLY VENOMOUS

Not thought to be harmful

HARMLESS

Not dangerous to humans










