COMMON SNAKES OF WINSTON PARK



Winston Park has around forty different types of snakes. Five species are highly venomous, while three others can inflict a rather painful bites. Eight species are considered mildly venomous. Twenty species are harmless.

HIGHLY VENOMOUS

Has caused human fatalities **VENOMOUS**

Painful bite, but does not require antivenom

MILDLY **VENOMOUS**

Not thought to be harmful **HARMLESS**

Not dangerous to humans










