





## Six-eyed Sand Spider


(Sicarius sp.)



Maximum size 30 - 40 mm



They are inoffensive and when disturbed, pull in the legs to form a tough ball. Bites are basically unheard of. It is reported that the venom is highly toxic in lab tests, but bites have not been reported in literature. They are distributed in the dry western half of the region.
