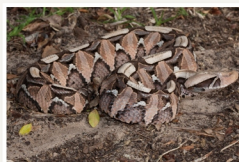

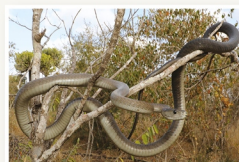
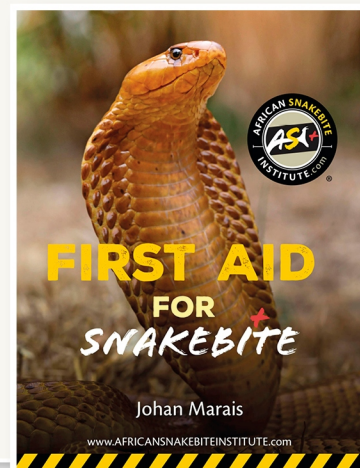

WHAT TO DO...

Immobilise the
victim and
promptly transport
to hospital.

Elevate the affected
limb slightly above
the heart and
immobilise the limb.
**NO PRESSURE
BANDAGES**

Wrap the affected
limb in a pressure
bandage and
apply a splint.

Apply mouth-
to-mouth
resuscitation.
Make use of a
Bag Valve Mask.
