

COMMON SNAKES OF MPUMALANGA



Mpumalanga has 72 different types of snakes. Seven species are highly venomous. Nine species are venomous and two can give a painful bite. Nineteen are mildly venomous and 35 species are harmless to humans.

HIGHLY VENOMOUS

Has caused human fatalities

VENOMOUS

Painful bite, but does not require antivenom

MILDLY VENOMOUS

Not thought to be harmful

HARMLESS

Not dangerous to humans
